What is an apprenticeship?

An apprenticeship is a paid job where you will learn new skills and gain valuable work experience.

Alongside on-the-job training, apprentices spend at least 20% of their working hours completing classroom-based learning with a Training Provider, like EMA, which leads to a nationally-recognised qualification.

You will be gaining on-the-job experience while earning a wage and gaining a nationally recognised qualification. Completing an EMA apprenticeship is an excellent way to gain practical experience, skills, and knowledge that can be implemented straight into the workplace.



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What are the requirements to become an apprentice?

You must be 16 or older to apply for an apprenticeship.

There are different requirements per level, as shown below:

Level 3 courses:

Level 3 programmes require 5 GCSE grades C/4.
Must include Maths and English or equivalent.

Level 4 courses:

Either A-Levels, or a Level 3 Apprenticeship or other relevant qualification, relevant experience.

Higher (Levels 4 and 5)	Foundation degree	13 - 24 months
Degree (Levels 6 and 7)	Bachelor's / Masters degree	24 months

Level 3 apprenticeship courses are equivalent to A-Levels.

Level 4 apprenticeship courses are equivalent to Foundation Degrees.

Level 7 apprenticeship courses are equivalent to Masters Degrees.

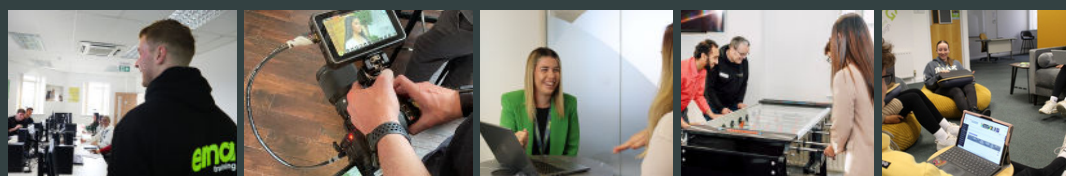
